

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

2018 NCHA SELECT SALE

1. The vendor must be a FULL member of the NCHA Inc.
2. All horses must be available for inspection prior to the sale.
3. Horses must be presented to the satisfaction of appointed association inspectors. The inspectors may reject a horse from the sale if the horse does not comply with the following conditions:
 - a) Markings and brands described on the entry form must be clearly visible and identical to the horse presented for inspection.
 - b) The horse should be prepared and presented suitably for the sale.
 - c) The horse should be free of undesirable characteristics and conformation faults.
4. NCHA/Landmark reserves the right to restrict the number of entries.
5. Horses for the sale will be selected by criteria.
6. Vendors entering two (2) year old horses are required to submit a video of their horses working at time of nomination, for the selection committee to view and decide suitability to the NCHA Select Sale.
7. There will be no refunds on acceptance of nominated horse/s into the Select Sale Catalogue.
8. **At the completion of the sale, all vendors' horses sold through Landmark will be refunded the \$330.00 (inc. GST) Marketing Fee which will be credited to the net proceeds of the sale.**
9. Vendors are advised that in line with NCHA/Landmark Drug Policy on prohibited substances in horses, that random drug tests may be carried out for lots consigned to the sale both prior to sale and following that lot having been offered for sale. Positive results from this testing may result in any catalogued lot being rejected from the sale or appropriate funds derived from the sale of such lot being withheld.
10. Commission of 8% (+ GST) of the gross purchase price of each lot will be deducted from the gross proceeds by the Acting Agent.
11. Vendors will be provided with a full copy of the conditions of sale.
12. Any information supplied on the nomination form that is found to be inaccurate or misleading may result in immediate disqualification from the sale and nomination fees will be forfeited. Any vendor discovered misrepresenting a sale horse does so at the risk of being charged with a federal offence.
13. The agent reserves the right to sell the horse out of catalogue order and/or reject any horse from the sale.
14. Vendors will be given the opportunity of working their sale horses on cattle during the selling of said sale horse (applicable for two (2) year old and trained horses only).
15. Landmark reserves the right to edit/alter catalogue notes.
16. Horses being worked on cattle are required to submit a video of the horse being worked for viewing during the Futurity. Videos can be emailed to hannah.murray@landmark.com.au

17. Embryos must be planted into a recipient mare and the recipient mare will become the property of the purchaser. The recipient mare must provide a pregnancy certificate (signed by registered veterinarian) dated no earlier than 14 days prior to sale date. This condition also applies to natural pregnancies in broodmares.
18. Where the vendor has retained semen or embryos, this fact must be disclosed by the vendor to the auctioneer prior to the sale of the lot. These facts will be announced at time of sale.
19. A full list of eligible sales incentives, including their terms and conditions, can be found in the 2018 NCHA Select Cutting Horse Sale Catalogue section 13.

I declare that all markings and brands on the horse match those on the certificate of registration. I acknowledge that I have read and agree to the Landmark Drugs Policy.

2018 SALE INCENTIVE

\$75,000 Open Futurity Yearling Incentive

Futurity horses will be eligible to compete for the incentive providing that:

1. Only yearlings offered for sale at the 2018 NCHA Select Sale will be eligible in 2020.
2. The sale horse is nominated by the vendor as provided on the entry form, and the fee of \$550.00 (inc. GST) is paid with the entry.
3. In the event that a yearling has not been nominated by the vendor, then the purchaser may nominate the purchased yearling and pay the fee of \$550.00 (inc. GST) as provided for on the buyer instruction slip handed to the agents conducting the sale.
4. Yearlings must be either sold under the hammer or sold through the agents by 5pm the day following the sale, and must be nominated and the fee paid as per rule 2 or 3.
5. Horses nominated /fee paid for by the vendor pre-sale and passed in will remain eligible to compete for the incentive prize, providing that the full commission is paid by the vendor to the agent by 5pm the day following the sale (calculated on the reserve price set by the vendor with the agent prior to sale in writing).
6. Horses nominated/fee paid for by the vendor that is passed in and no commission is paid to the agent as per condition 5, will be ineligible to compete for the incentive and the nomination fee of \$550.00 will be refunded by the NCHA to the vendor.
7. Once a horse is acknowledged by the NCHA as being eligible for the incentive then that right will be transferable from owner to owner if the horse is sold prior to the futurity being held.
8. The NCHA will recognise the eligibility of those yearlings nominated for the incentive in writing following the sale.
